

Portable Table Fold up Instructions

These tables are very handy at our Camps. When they are folded up correctly they are easier to move as well as easier to store at the Quartermasters location.

The problem is that it is not very intuitive to assemble these correctly. If they are not folded up correctly, pieces fallout as you are carrying them. It can be a real pain.

The following photos will hopefully help you in the field...

Step one: Place table top on ground with the smooth side down and the two bolts poking up through the holes in the top.



Step 2: Place one of the end pieces (seen in the bottom of the photo in step one) on top of the tabletop. Note the orientation of this end piece.



NOTE: Make sure that the End piece is the one WITHOUT the holes. Also, make sure that the eyelet is facing down.

Step 3: Place the two bench pieces as well as one of the bench supports on the top of the pile. Make sure that the bench support (smaller piece of wood) is in the center.



Step 4: Place the table support on the pile. Note the orientation of this piece. Also, place the other bench support butted against the table support with the tabs facing away from the table support.



Step 5: Place remaining end piece in the orientation shown and tighten the nuts.



Ta Dah!!! Load them up and get them back to the Quartermaster!
